Progress continues to be made in our project for a new, state-of-the-art community centre.

Prairie Architects have been hired and will have a conceptual design ready for public information this spring. An open house to receive community input is being planned at the Silver Heights Community Club. We'll be sure to notify the residents of our area when we have a confirmed date. The facility we envision will be impressive to say the least.

In the meantime, a critical delivery date has been established: construction is scheduled for this summer (August) with completion aimed for March 31, 2011. As we all know, these dates are flexible, dependant on a number of factors, including weather, unforeseen construction issues and availability of materials. But, let's all cross our fingers for good luck!

During construction, all programs will be relocated to the Silver Heights site. I know all our residents will be patient with us. The magnitude of this project is staggering, but the end result will be a state-of-the-art facility. The focus of the new facility will be a regulation-size gymnasium, large multi-purpose room, central kitchen and spacious dressing rooms.

Our new community centre will be built to Manitoba Green Building Policy standards. Funding for this \$4.5M project has been provided equally by all three levels of government.
